Do you have matches/challenges?

- Tailor to encourage engagement at crucial times on or leading up to December 1st
- What match/challenge strategies will help you reach your goals?
- Keep the details of your match as clear as possible
 - What goal do you need to reach? When is the match active? What is the gift to match ratio? What do donors need to do to have their gift matched?
- Brand, promote your match leading up to and on the day
 - Support Catholic Charities on 12/1 during the "Double Dollar Dash!" Every donation received on 12/1 will be matched, thanks to our sponsor.



#iGiveCatholic Ambassadors

How will you get your donations?

If collecting funds directly:

- Donations will be transferred to your bank account 5-7 days after #iGiveCatholic
- Each online donation record will include a "Payout Date" to represent the date it was deposited. Donations listed as "Pending" have not yet successfully transferred.
- Note: Offline gifts your team entered in the dashboard would not count in this payout, as you should have collected those directly.



How will you get your donations?

- If your arch/diocese/foundation is collecting funds on your behalf:
 - Download a report of online gifts from #iGiveCatholic 2020 to determine how much you should receive.
 - Note: Offline gifts your team entered in would not count in this payout, as you should have received those directly.
 - If you have any questions regarding the timing of payout, etc. contact your diocesan/foundation point person





How will you thank your donors?

- Start your stewardship process immediately after #iGiveCatholic
- Pre-schedule general messaging to all supporters
 - Social media posts and overall success update
 - Giving Day thank you email to your organization's email list
- Follow up with donors for more personal stewardship
 - Access their contact information in your GiveGab Dashboard
- Highlight impact of donor funded projects
 - This doesn't have to happen right away!



Q:How can we add the goal bar to be visualized on the giving website?

A:Thanks for reaching out. If set on a profile, the goal bar will become visible on the Giving Day when overall sites stats are on. Let me know if you have any follow-up questions.

Q:1. Is there a field to put free form in? If so is there a character limit? We are going to be doing in honor and in memory of and want to make sure that we have enough space. 2. Do we need to add a campaign? If so where? 3. Is there a central website where the can go and search for our school?

A:Within your organization dashboard there is a great section that you can use right within the "tell your story" section. This will allow you to add as much content you like to your organization's profile.

- 2. You are not obligated to a campaign, or "Support Area" that is under your main organization. That is an optional feature you can use if you want to highlight a certain program or initiative.
- 3. Your Diocese will have a general site where donors can search for your organization, but donors are also able to look on the gener #<u>iGiveCatholic.org</u> site as well.





Q: Is it strongly suggested to set a goal to be raised?

A: Setting a goal can help motivate and incentivize donors to give an extra amount to help your organization reach its goal.

Q: Can we link our organization's social media to the website?

A: Your organization's page on #iGiveCatholic will have the options to share on FB, but one is not able to add custom social media accounts to the page. You are able to add information in the story section linking out to your social media pages if you like. Hope that helped. :)

Q: Do you have ideas on how to promote matching gifts?

A: Definitely! We've seen organizations pick specific times for the match and promote that time. For example a Lunch Break match which encourages donors to give from 12-1, this would allow donors to give during their lunch break and may encourage donors to share with their colleagues. Other organizations create a challenge, that will unlock when they reach a specific number of donors which can make it exciting for donors to try and reach that number of donors. For a challenge, reaching a goal will unlock a fund.



Q: Do you guys recommend sharing the link to the diocesan landing page with our potential donors, or the link directly to our ministry's profile?

A: We suggest you share the link directly to your profile page!

Q: Is there pre written text somewhere that we can use, already written for us to tweak and repost onto social media? For use now and as we countdown. TY!

A: Yes! On the website under Menu, select Resources. There is a Marketing Toolkit you can download with sample posts for Facebook, Twitter and Instagram!

Q: When do we need people to send their donations to the parish through #iGiveCatholic?

A: Supporters can send their donations anytime between 11/16 and 12/1 and they should mark their donation is for #iGiveCatholic!

Q: If we are collecting offline donations, when is the last day to enter them into the system?

A: All offline donation must be entered by the December 2nd.





Q: Will the "choose your own amount" show up under giving levels automatically?

A: Yes! That "Choose your own amount" will automatically appear once a donation level has been added to a profile.

Q: Do donors get a tax exemption for their donation?

A: All online donors will receive a tax receipt as soon as they donate. Offline donors who give you checks or cash will only receive the tax receipt if you enter their email address into the system. If they don't give you their email, the parish will need to provide the tax receipt.

Q: Can you have too many donation level buttons? What is the optimal number of buttons?

A: We recommend approximately 3- 5 donation levels to allow for a good profile layout within mobile and not overwhelm your donors. However, there is no technical limit. Remember, set the donations levels to be at least \$25 or more.





Q: What if your organization is better known by an acronym than a full name?

A: Hi there, if the acronym is more commonly used, you can update the name of your page to reflect that acronym, this can be done on the Organization Information page.

Q: Can the link we send out go directly to our site instead of going through all these steps?

A: Yes you can certainly share the link to your organization's page directly.

Q: Do we get charged the fees if the donor opts not to cover them?

A: If the donor does not cover the fees it would be deducted from the payout amount to your organization.

Q: Is there a fee for the final total that our organization raises?

A: Nope, there are only fees charged to the individual donation transaction fees.





Q: Does NCEA keep any portion of the proceeds outside the fees?

A: Please feel free to reach out to the main contact at NCEA for whether or not NCEA charges any fees.

Q: If we are posting cash donations to go toward the giving total, do any fees come out of that total? Obviously, no fees out of the cash gift are given, but does the total amount get captured?

A: There are no fees applied to offline donations!

Q: What are the fee applied to each donation?

A: The fees applied to each online donation is 6.2%, plus \$.30.
