Save the Date Banner for Email Signature Lines and Archdiocesan Website Cover Page

To jump start preparations, look for 3-4 images that you can use to create an Arch/diocesan Save the Date announcement. These images should represent the beauty of your diocesan ministries and work. It should be used for email signature lines for arch/diocesan personnel and posted one month out on the arch/diocesan website. Participants can replicate this using their unique photos and URL.
