




## **Customize Name**

 Shorten or customize part of your link to make it more shareable!








- Designate or update the "point of contact" for your organization



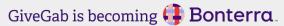








### How do I verify my organization?

- 1. Navigate to your organization's "Bank Account & Verification" page
- 2. Enter your EIN and click "Save"
- 3. Click "Verify Your Organization" (see second image)











# How do I verify my organization?

- 4. Enter your information via secure Stripe-hosted onboarding form
- 5. Click "Submit"









### Checklist for Successful Verification

- Determine your organization representative
- Review the <u>Steps to become verified on GiveGab</u> support articles:
  - How does this process work?
  - □ Video explanation of verification process
- Enter the requested information as soon as possible
  - You can skip the State Solicitation Attestation step!
- ☐ Check your dashboard again in 5-7 business days. Not verified? Reach out to GiveGab's customer support team.

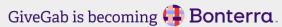

# Importance of a Great Profile Page

Outward-facing message - make it something of which you are PROUD!

### **Elements to Consider:**

- PROFILE IMAGE: "A picture is worth a thousand words..."
- THERMOMETER: Set goal and tracking of progress
- DONATION LEVELS: Demonstrate impact to donors
- STORY: Describe what you do and why it's important in VIDEO and WORDS






### BUT! Don't just make a great profile page...

- You can make the most aesthetically pleasing profile page in the world and it will mean nothing if no one sees it!
- Be sure to SHARE your profile page with your community- through social media, newsletters, bulletins, pulpit announcements etc.



# Key Feature #1 - Matches/Challenges

### **DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR MATCH**

When a gift is made, an offline gift releases and is added to organization totals.

You can now choose 2:1 or 3:1 ratios for automated matches.

<u>HERE</u> is how to add a matching gift to your profile

### **CHALLENGE**

A gift is unlocked when a certain threshold is reached (Either # donors or dollars)

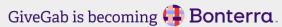
<u>HERE</u> is how to add a challenge gift to your profile

Organizations with matches/challenges raise 10 X more on average

★ Last year \$2,244,096.02 in matching gifts from 138 organizations

### Challenge Examples

Based on number of donors in a specific time window. Adds urgency!

#### Matches

Based on dollars raised towards goal. **Builds momentum!** 

The Drake Family: 25 unique donors during Early Giving

A generous donor has offered a challenge grant of \$750 if PCRS has 25 unique donors between now and midnight, November 28th!!

\$750 unlocked!

Anonymous: The Donna Henry \$30K Challenge\*

A generous donor has offered a \$5000 challenge grant if the PCRS Giving Tuesday total reaches \$30,000!!!

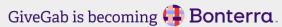


### Potential Match/Challenge Donors

- THOSE WHO WANT TO HELP INSPIRE OTHERS!
- Board Members
- Larger Donors
- Local Businesses (including bulletin or program book advertisers)
- Consider Pooling Resources
- Handful of them in Year #1 start somewhere!

50%+ of donors in our post-giving day survey reported that a matching gift was highly motivating and an important component of their support.





## **Key Feature #2 - Peer-to-Peer**

### **WHAT IS PEER-TO-PEER?**

- Ambassadors who fundraise on your behalf
- Share connection with your ministry and impact it has had
- Profile page is connected to yours donations in your totals
- Organizations using P2P raise 7.5X more on average





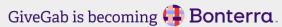


# Key Feature #2 - Peer-to-Peer (cont.)

### You can also use for Individuals or Groups!

- Healthy Competition is good!
  - Parishes Ministries or Mass Time Communities
  - Schools By Grade Level or Alumni Years/Decades
  - Ministries Board Members or Service Recipient (i.e. college student for a campus ministry)






# **Key Feature #3 - Support Areas**

- Showcase an organization's programs or special campaigns
- Earmarked funds help clarify donor passion and intent
  - Ministries/Catholic Charities highlight specific programs
  - Schools extracurriculars (Athletics, Music, Arts, etc.)
  - Parishes multiple projects you want to fund (Youth ministry retreat, renovating adoration chapel, liturgical music program, etc.)



### **Cost of Online Fundraising**

- A.K.A. Fees assessed on Online Donations
  - Stripe processing fees are ubiquitous and unavoidable
  - GiveGab platform fee is less than it would be independent of #iGiveCatholic
  - #iGiveCatholic only takes 1.55% to support program
  - Nearly 75% of donors covered the fee in 2023
    - Offline gifts incur no fees
  - Infographic resource available <u>HERE</u>





If the donor gives by ACH\*

3.3% + \$3.00

#### 1.55% HOST COST

#iGiveCatholic uses these funds to support the entire Giving Day process from start to finish on the #iGiveCatholic platform, including our project management work with GiveGab/Bonterra and diocesan partners on the site, development of promotional resources, graphics, expenses related to filing in all states as a registered fundraiser, cyber insurance, communications, software, accounting, and all the costs associated with running a non-profit.

DONORS HAVE THE OPTION TO PAY THE ONLINE COSTS FOR ORGANIZATIONS —

AND IN 2023, 73.4% DID!

#### 1.75% PLATFORM COST

These funds are used by Bonterra (#iGiveCatholic platform partner) to maintain all the behind-the-scenes technology, security, reporting, and tech support. Think Blue Chat Bubble!

#### \$3 for ACH or 2.5% + 30¢ for Credit Card

For Stripe, the payment processor. One \$.30 charge per credit card transaction, no matter how many gifts they make in that transaction, plus 2.5% of total credit card donation.

98.62¢

is the average amount an organization received per dollar donated in 2023.
