Created and launched in the Archdiocese of New Orleans, #iGiveCatholic has grown to yield great national impact. According to the Giving USA 2019 Annual Report on Philanthropy, a total of \$11.4 million raised on #GivingTuesday in 2018 went towards religion-related causes. That same year, #iGiveCatholic nationally raised more than \$5.6 million meaning the Giving Day program generated nearly half of all #GivingTuesday 2018 religious-related donations. This year’s initiative will almost double the amount of parishes, schools and nonprofit ministries participating under the umbrella of 39 dioceses from across the country.

“The growth of #iGiveCatholic on #GivingTuesday and how it is motivating people to make a difference in their own communities is truly inspiring,” said Kyle Hamilton, CEO of OSV, this year’s national sponsor. “We are proud to partner with #iGiveCatholic to sponsor this extraordinary national day of gratitude and generosity and look forward to uniting to do good, inspire action and collectively raise millions for so many parishes, schools and nonprofit ministries on Tuesday, December 3.”
