



PRIZE POOL SCHEDULE

The Community Foundation of Louisville has secured over \$312,000 for the Give For Good Louisville 2019 Prize Pool.

BONUS POOL

The \$126,000 Bonus Pool will be distributed equally among every nonprofit that reaches the following fundraising/donation tiers:

Tier #1:	Secure 30 unique donations	equal split of \$42,000
Tier #2:	Secure 60 unique donations	equal split of \$42,000
Tier #3:	Secure 90 unique donations	equal split of \$42,000

*A "Unique Donation" is defined as one gift of \$10 or more to one organization from one donor. Anyone who attempts to game the system runs the risk of being caught in our audit. Prizes may be withheld if unique donations can't be verified.

P2P Powerhouse	Nonprofit that raises the highest dollar amount through the P2P fundraising feature	\$1,000

Match Maker	Nonprofit that fulfills the most matching donations (in dollars raised) on their profile	\$1,000
#GiveForGoodLouLIVE	Nonprofit who has the most creative Facebook Live video using both the following hashtags: #GiveForGoodLou & #GiveForGoodLouLIVE	\$1,000

DELTA DENTAL GOLDEN TICKETS

Delta Dental will be Making Smiles Happen with \$24,000 in **Golden Tickets** on September 12. Every hour of the 24-hour give day, a lucky donation will be randomly selected to receive a Golden Ticket and \$1,000 will be added to the donation. That means a donation as little as \$10 can become \$1,010!

Additionally, Delta Dental is offering *additional* prizes for organizations who provide human oral health care. There will be three \$2,000 **Smile Prizes** selected at 12:30 PM among eligible nonprofits.

For each drawing, a random number generator will select a donation from all donations received during the designated time period. Community Foundation staff will announce the winning nonprofits and donors on social media channels throughout the day.

*Organizations cannot win more than one Golden Ticket throughout the day. An organization cannot win more than one Smile Prize throughout the day. An organization could win a Golden Ticket and a Smile Prize.

MATCH MINUTES

This year, dollars will go further during pre-set match minute(s). Matching minutes will help double donations during these pre-set times: 1:40 PM, 5:40 PM, 9:40 PM.

Please note:

- Each match minute has a pool of \$10,000. Once that amount is exhausted, the matching opportunity is over.
- Matching minute dollars are distributed on a first come, first served basis, according to the corresponding timestamp on the gift transaction.
- This will be a dollar-for-dollar match on every gift up to \$100 until the \$10,000 runs out. Gifts above \$100 will receive a match for the first \$100.
- Gifts made during the match minute(s) are also eligible for prizes.

SOUTHERN INDIANA PROPORTIONATE MATCH POOLS

Organizations based in these counties will be eligible to receive a proportionate share of the these match pools based on their overall amount of dollars raised, excluding other bonus or prizes they may receive. (e.g. 5% of the funds raised in S. Indiana = 5% of the corresponding proportionate match pool.)



- A "Unique Donation" is defined as one gift of \$10 or more to one organization from one donor. Anyone who attempts to game the system runs the risk of being caught in our audit.
- In the event of ties, prizes will be split.
- Nonprofits can only win one Golden Ticket prize throughout the day.
- Nonprofits can only win one Smile Prize throughout the day.
- Nonprofits may win one Golden Ticket & one Smile Prize throughout the day.
- Community Foundation of Louisville fundholder distributions count towards the Bonus Pool and Grand Prizes, but are not eligible for Golden Tickets or time-based strategic prizes.
- Nonprofits selected their size category at registration and their size was validated against the organization's 990.
